- Extra clothes
- Pacifier (If necessary)
- Sleep sack (If necessary)
- Food (Baby food or snacks, AbLaze does provide lunch when child transitions to table food)
- Family Picture to hang in the classroom (You can bring in a printed copy or email your teacher)
